PATIENT

- Age < 70
- No major co-morbidities
- No pre-existing major neurological deficits
- Full/Presumed Full Code

CARDIAC ARREST

- Witnessed in-hospital arrest + early HQ CPR
- No ROSC after 5 mins
- Cause of arrest:
 - Presumed cardiac or no obvious cause
 - Pulmonary embolism
 - o Cardiac toxin overdose

TIPS:

- Emergency physicians and nurses should **continue managing Code Blue as per usual**. ECMO team will perform/assist with cannulation.
- Ensure two ultrasound machines are present.
- Bring the metal procedure table with the ECMO
 kit (angio drapes and gloves) to bedside.
- Avoid femoral CVC access.
- Crowd control! Only the usual outreach team is required (plus one as a runner, if available).
